MALTA MUZZLE-LOADING SHOOTING CLUB



A Short History of Black Powder Shooting in Malta

Black powder (BP) shooting in Malta started way back in 1989 when a Napoleonic re-enactment was staged at the Armed Forces of Malta ranges in Pembroke. Original flintlock and percussion guns





were used since at the time it was not possible to import any firearms other than shotguns. It was thanks to the assistance of Brig. Maurice Calleja that this first event ever got under way.

Having broken the ice, this was followed by monthly shooting events at the AFM Safi Pistol Range. The Army provided Range Conducting Officers (RCO) and shooting used to take place on the 1st Sunday of each month. As BP was the only shooting discipline permitted almost all members participated. Attendance of more than 30 shooters was quite common. It took ages between a round and another, the interval was always filled with discussions about shooting, powder weight, techniques. This was invariably punctuated by a good dose of jokes, clean or otherwise!

Eventually RCO courses were organised by the AFM and soon after we did not have to depend on the presence of an AFM RCO. We managed to acquire permission to shoot every Sunday and soon after also on Saturdays.

The increased number of shooting days and especially the introduction of cartridge firearms following the coming into force of the Arms Act in 2006 saw a decline in the enthusiasm and attendance in black powder shooting events; members opted for the new toy in town, the smokeless cartridge and its guns, that meant less hassle to load and clean. What really hit black powder hard though was the AFM closing its Safi range gates to civilian shooters.

Fortunately the private range at Handaq became accessible - a blessing for the shooting fraternity. Shooters could once again practice their sport. Yet again the trend was in favour of centerfire cartridges and the range mainly catered for this discipline. However a number of members have shown keen interest in shooting their BP guns again and the Malta Muzzle-Loading Shooting Club (MMSC) has come to an agreement with the Victoria Shooting Range operators so that its members can shoot Black Powder on particular days. Pre-booking is necessary.

As a first step we shall be holding a meeting on Wednesday, 20 June at 1930 hours at the Club premises in Tigne' Point. Members interested in BP shooting and intending to acquire a Target Shooter Licence B (Muzzle Loader) are urged to book a seat by contacting Franco at <u>info@amacs-malta.org</u>

As for the BP veterans it's time to unpack your old trusted muzzle loader and prepare to use it again! Send your comments to <u>info@amacs-malta.org</u>.
